Footnotes

SOUTH CHINA SEA broke sharply to stalk the pace of COAL MINER CHARLIE from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the three-sixteenths pole, quickly drew off and was ridden out to the wire to be kept to task. COAL MINER CHARLIE sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, could not stay with the winner in the drive but held on well to save the place. BOSTON BREW was never far back while racing along the inside and lacked the needed closing response. PIROGUE was off slow, began to advance from the outside through the second turn and found his best stride late. JULIAS WILD SIDE raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn, angled inside nearing the furlong marker and failed to gain late. BREAK SEVENTY chased the leaders from the outside for a half and gradually weakened. COPPER POPPER was off slow, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. RICE COVE EXPRESS lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten. CAJUN ENTOURAGE showed brief speed and weakened. ONE FREE SHOT steadied at the break, dropped far back early, was pulled up nearing the three-sixteenths marker and walked off.
