Footnotes

TWO TO LOAD was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole, moved between foes late and was up in the closing yards. MAKE MINE CASH raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and finished with good energy. RUNAWAY STEPHEN was bumped at the break, lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with a steady bid. RESTLESS BULL raced wide through the first turn, moved up rapidly to take command with a furlong to run, opened a clear margin and gave way through the final yards. TIME AND A HALF was off slow and bumped, saved ground throughout and finished evenly in the drive. DU BOIS dueled for the lead from the outside, opened a clear margin nearing the half and gave way into the stretch. TIZ THE KID broke awkwardly, raced wide through the second turn and failed to rally. EL'S INTOIT was off a step slow, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. LOVER OF ART was forwardly placed early and gradually weakened. WOLF PACK JACK broke sharply to duel for the early advantage and weakened after going three furlongs.
