BAMJAN stalked the early front runners, began to advance position heading into the turn, raced between rivals in the top of the stretch and rallied in the drive to prevail. JOHN CHARLES raced up close and vied for the lead with ROYAL EXPRESS, shook free and took command in the upper stretch but could not keep up the pace in the late drive. RICHMAR stalked the early front runners, steadily began to advance position heading into the turn, raced five wide and rallied to get up in time for show. RAIL RIDGE stalked the early pacesetters, raced in crowded upper stretch, angled to the rail and failed to rally late. ROYAL EXPRESS dueled for the lead with JOHN CHARLES, matched strides until the upper stretch and had nothing left in the drive. STONEY GOLD saved ground along the inside and was no threat. PLACE VALUE made a bid in the early going and had nothing left in the drive. RANGER DANGER hopped at the start and was never a factor.
