HEY PODZ stalked the early front runners, steadily began to advance position along the outside, raced three wide in the turn, took command in the upper stretch and steadily drew clear. ROMAN DECISION took command early and remained clear by a slight margin, felt pressure heading into the turn, drifted out in the top of the stretch causing TOUGH AS NAILS to check sharply and could not keep pace late. STORM SNOW stalked the early pacesetters, steadily began to advance position heading into the turn, raced four wide and was up in time to capture third. ROLL BACK tracked the early front runners along the inside, continued to save ground in the turn and came up empty in the late drive. TOUGH AS NAILS raced up close behind the early pacesetter, advanced position up to the leader heading into the turn, was forced to check sharply and steadily weakened. M. V. P. HONOR raced evenly and failed to threaten. LAYNE'S PAL was fractious in the gate and was never a factor. RAILWAY lacked response throughout. PADRE MIO failed to respond. After viewing replays stewards disqualified # 5 ROMAN DECISION from second and placed him fifth for interference in the upper stretch
