SACK O ROCKS showed quick speed away from the gate and took command, continued the leader heading into the turn, raced along the inside in the stretch and held clear to prevail. TRUE stalked the early front runner, steadily began to advance position on the outside, raced four wide in the turn, improved position but could not catch the leader in the drive. SLEW OF MEDALS raced up close tracking the early pacesetter, raced three wide in the turn, briefly matched strides with rivals in the upper stretch and held on for show. SOUTHPINE saved ground along the inside, remained near the rail in the turn, briefly matched strides with rivals in the upper stretch and came up empty late. SERA'S TUNNEL stalked the early front runners and failed to rally in the drive. HAZELSHEARTSTRINGS raced five wide in the stretch turn and was no threat late. GOLFSHOT made a brief bid in the early going and steadily faded. QUEEN OF BROADWAY raced near the inside and was never a factor. ANNIE ONE showed little and was eased up in the stretch.
