THE LAST WAVE went to the front, led throughout, pulled away and won handily. JENNY'S SAY pressed the pace, forwardly placed throughout, proved no match for the winner, but was a clear second. WAJIR ON ME broke a step slow, racing in the back, gained ground, drifted in down the home stretch, made a rail bid and held third. After viewing replay, Stewards disqualified him and placed him fifth. CONSULT raced in the middle of the field, eased back, came around the final turn four wide, made a late bid and was outfinished for third. KISS THE GOLD lacked early speed, moved up, clipped heels, checked, down the home stretch and finished evenly. BOLD LOUISA'S BOY pressed the early pace and faded on the inside. ROSE'S PRIDE raced near the back, came around the first turn four wide and was outrun.
