GO GO WALK unhurried in the early part, came around the turn three wide, made a late rally and got up in time. VERLANDER void of early speed, came around the turn four wide and closed fast. DOMINATING CAT vied for the early lead, drove clear and was outfinished late by the top two. BAD JOHN raced in the middle of the field, made a mild bid, but was no factor. MIKE KEY challenged for the early lead and faded. BUSTER HUT raced in the middle of the field and put forth an even effort. THE COUG raced near the back and was never a factor. TOM T showed early speed and dropped back. TEXAS CITY MAC got loose before the start, raced within contention and retreated. WILD POSSE broke in the back, striding short, pulled up and was vanned off.
