BANDIDO challenged for the early advantage, took the lead entering the final turn, drove clear and was kept to the task. JOHN CHARLES broke out, dueled for the early lead, forwardly placed throughout, proved no match late for the winner, but held on for second. HALLWAY void of early speed, came around the final turn four wide, made a wide bid and missed second. HEELBOLT broke in, pressed the pace and lacked a finish. NOWANDFOREVERMORE shuffled back at the start, improved position, but was no factor. LEE'S SAY SO raced near the middle of the field and was no threat late. POPPA DUKE raced within contention and faded. LATCH LIGHTING raced in the middle of the field, came around the first turn four wide and retreated. ZARB'S GUNNER void of early speed, came around the first turn five wide and showed little.
