**Footnotes**

BLUE CHOICE broke well to dispute the pace racing well off the rail through the backstretch, secured a clear advantage nearing the turn, angled inwards a bit on the bend and held safe the challenge of I'M A TUDOR under some urging. The latter quickly showed in front, attended the pace while switching outside the winner on the bend, challenged in the drive but proved second best. SARAH CALLING shifted sharply off the rail on the backstretch while chasing the pace, continued three deep to the lane but could make no impression on the top pair. I'MA BELEK TOO hopped at the break, was bumped by SCOOTER'S CHARM, raced outside the leaders to the lane and couldn't produce the necessary closing response. A WISH FOR YOU tracked the pace between foes to the turn but offered no rally. PLAIN SUGAR tracked the pace in hand through the backstretch, raced four wide on the turn but proved no factor. SCOOTER'S CHARM broke outwards, bumped a rival at the start, settled off that foe and never menaced thereafter. TICKLISH DOENY was off awkwardly and bumped by MISTY SPECTRE at the start, then trailed the field to the lane. MISTY SPECTRE broke out, bumped a rival, altered course to avoid SARAH CALLING on the backstretch and quickly dropped out on the turn.
