BITTERSWEET BONNIE stalked the leader in the early part, racing three wide around the first turn, took the advantage around the final turn, drove clear and finished well. BACKTHAT THING UP unhurried in the beginning, moved up outside around the final turn and followed the winner down the stretch. BRITNEY DIANNE lacked early speed, made a late mild bid, but proved no match for the top two. CLASSIC N BELIEVE went to the front, drove clear, then weakened. HERE'S BRITTANY lacked early speed, raced four wide around both turns, moved up and finished evenly. TURK'S LUCK always raced near the back and showed little. SILENT BAYOU raced within contention, came around the first turn three wide and faded. SIGNAL MIKE pressed the early pace, then stopped.
