SPICEY MOMENT angled in to the rail once clear on the backstretch, improved her position inside rivals, then slipped through on the rail racing into the stretch to forge clear in late stages under steady pressure. LACIE J was outpaced racing along the inside in the early stages, angled out to race five wide leaving the furlong pole and finished evenly while gaining second in the final strides. GOAL AND COUNT was taken in hand soon after the break, angled outside rivals to race six wide into the lane and was outfinished for second in late stages. SILENTBUTDELITEFUL was bumped at the start by the winner, recovered to race four wide into the turn, then switched inside to split foes in the lane while making a mild gain late. DERBY DREAM was reserved along the inside early but could produce no rally when called upon. EXCLUSIVE EMOTION was hustled up from the outset while angling inwards to duel for command to the stretch, then weakened once headed. C THRU TEDDY tracked the leaders racing along in the second flight, loomed three deep on the turn, then hung nearing the furlong pole. NICHOLS DEE LIGHT was hustled outside rivals to duel for command to the turn and gave way.
