HIGH LOW GAME pressed the pace, raced outside around the final turn, dueled down the stretch and prevailed for the win. ILE ST. LOUISVILLE bumped start, vied for the early lead, forwardly placed throughout, saved ground around the final turn, dueled down the lane, was outfinished for the win, but proved best of others. SAINT RAYMOND unhurried in the early part, made a stead gain, but was no match for the top two. STONE SKIPPER bumped at the start, vied for the early lead and weakened. THISONESFOMYNINJAS void of early speed and was never a factor. ONE MILLION RUBIES raced within contention, saved ground around the second turn and faded. TUCKERS TERROR raced near the back, came around the first turn four wide and was no threat.
