TRACK RECORD unhurried in the early going, moved up, four wide around the final turn and drove clear late. HANDSOME BLUE raced within striking distance, saved ground around the final turn, made a bid, but proved no match for the winner. SEFAPIANO JR. lacked early speed, made a late bid and got up for third. DESSY pressed the pace, forwardly placed throughout and was outfinished for third. CAPE BIRD bobbed at the start, vied for the early lead and weakened. ELUSIVE COMMANDER broke poorly, racing in the rear, improved position, but was no factor. ZAVA JACK raced within contention and faded. TIGER MONARCH went to the front, moved toward the rail and was finished early. DEGA PAPILLON raced near the back and was never a factor. INSIDE STRIKE raced within striking distance, came around the first turn four wide and retreated.
