Footnotes

HAWK'S TUNNEL unhurried in the early part, came around the final turn five wide and got up late. FIRST COMMAND raced in the back of the pack in the beginning, made a late bid, racing four wide and finished willingly. PROLONGED went to the front, drove clear and lacked a finish. GIVETHEBALLTOROLF raced near the back in the beginning, made a bid and hung. GEOCACHE lacked early speed, came around the second turn six wide, showed late interest, but was no factor. ALL OUT BLITZ raced within contention, saved ground around the final turn and faded. ROYAL TREATY void of early speed and was never close. TOP COP raced within striking distance and faded. CONGA ROCK was an early factor and finished early. LYPHARD'S GOLD vied for the early lead and dropped back.
