COCOA'S KNOCKOUT was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while five wide, powered up to the front then drew off in mid stretch and was clearly best. MAJOR CASE was settled on the inside on the run down the backstretch, made a bid two wide on the far turn then moved out to be three wide in mid stretch and finished well but was no menace to the winner. CUDA LEE vied for the lead while three wide, was in a long drive and gamely dug in but tired in late stretch. MYSTICAL FRIEND was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn but was no menace in the stretch. MALABAR CROWN was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while five wide but was no threat in the stretch. BLANCO BILLY was unhurried early and racing three wide then failed to menace. K ONE FOUR was unhurried early and no factor. LEE'S CONQUEST vied for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then faltered. STOLD DA GOLD vied for the early lead from between rivals, was used up and stopped before the far turn. BOBBYN BOUIE was unhurried early while inside then was blocked behind rivals nearing the far turn and stopped.
