### Footnotes

DAPPLE DOWN raced in the second flight past the wire the first time while outside, fell back while four wide through the first turn, continued unhurried up the backstretch, rallied five wide out of the final turn, finished willingly to be in time. BERTIE'S PLANET also raced four wide in the first turn when with the second group, rated off the pace, advanced and took over far turn, clear, could not contain the winner, all out to hold the place. WAR CHIEF within striking distance, between rivals and in traffic turning for home, slowly for the place. EMPTY PAGES back off the early pace, moved closer along the inside late backstretch, shuffled back early in the turn, between rivals into the stretch, went evenly to the wire. DOWMANIA allowed the pace to go early, three wide and between rivals into the lane, lacked a late kick. LINDAU pressured the early pace, put a head in front briefly in the second turn, could not last. GIANT MINGUN narrowly set the pace along the inside for a half, faltered when headed into the far turn. TURN AND REPENT never menaced from well back. BILL CITY last to leave, remained always back. ZARB'S WHIRL outrun in showing little.
