Footnotes

AUBREY'S DIAMOND away in good order, dueled up front while closest to the inside, headed into the lane, battled back in determined fashion to prove best. WHODATKNOWI'MTOUGH moved up to duel soon after the start off the inside, put a head in front through the turn, narrowly showed the way into the lane, lost the advantage the final sixteenth to be outfinished. AL TEE in the second flight along the inside, continued to save ground through the turn, proved no match for the top two in the drive, held sway for the show. GRAND AND GREY within striking distance off the inside, raced three wide out of the turn, lacked a closing response. MISS LA PRISS broke out, raced five wide through the turn, went evenly through the lane to improve position slightly. IRMASUE was never dangerous while three wide. PINK CASCADE lacked a response in the drive. BOCELLI'S SONG forwardly placed for three furlongs while between rivals, gave way. DAVORS JEWEL was always outrun. CAROL SNUCK IN in a bit tight at the start, trailed throughout.
