STRETCH O'BRIEN forwardly placed from the start off the inside, three wide turning for home when moving to challenge, gained the advantage soon after, held the runner up safe in the late going. ACE AND JIM off the early pace and the inside, came in slightly while four wide into and through the turn, set down for the drive, challenged the winner late, not enough. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF PART OF MY FAMILY AGAINST ACE AND JIM FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE INTO THE TURN WAS QUICKLY DISALLOWED. PART OF MY FAMILY off the pace while three wide, bothered slight into the far turn, lost fell back a bit through the bend, closed some ground late and was going willingly at the end to earn the show. POLY SAUCE last away, raced well back early, came seven wide into the stretch, improved position while remaining well out in the strip. SALTY AND FAST off the pace while saving some ground in the turn, moved out a bit in some traffic into the stretch, finished up evenly when clear. BILLY BO broke sharp, narrowly set the pace while between foes for three furlongs, briefly raced on equal terms with the winner upper stretch, faltered. BLAZING BANDIT lacked speed, came five wide out of the turn, managed little in the way of a rally. BAGGY CAT vied up front along the inside for three furlongs and backed up. TOO FROSTY pressured the early pace from the outside and also backed up. NITECAP trailed throughout in showing little.
