### Footnotes

ABASTADA broke alertly, got to the inside to set the pace, headed late backstretch, battled back inside, long drive, fully extended. LITEFOOTSUE closest to the leaders, three wide out of the final turn, roused, finished willingly to be in time for the place, getting to the winner. NATIVE HEAVEN pressured the winner from the outside, put a head in front into the far turn, dueled into and through the stretch, could not match late, outkicked by the runner up final strides. MALLORY'S DREAM allowed to settle off the early and the inside, moved closer, in some traffic late when continuing to close the gap gradually. HOTTIE'S DEELITE off the pace and the inside, raced four wide into the far turn and had nothing for the drive. ZARB'S BEST void of speed, bothered slightly, steered out to avoid a rival who was giving way, four wide into the stretch, improved a bit. BABY'S TRIBUTE lacked speed, in some traffic in the three path second turn, failed to muster a rally. I'MALITTLETRICKY jostled a bit at the start, raced inside, gave way far turn. SAPPHIRE STRIKE void of speed, carried out five wide turning for home, remained back. EARLY TO RISE tired while racing outside.
