SAINT FLOYD stalked the leaders off the inside, collared those two rivals nearing the sixteenth mile marker, drove clear. HO HO GOT U moved up to duel off the inside into the first turn, continued to alternate up front up the backstretch and through the final turn, could not match the winner the final sixteenth, proved game for the place. SHIRO cleared to the inside soon after the start, duelled closest to the inside, also proved no match for the winner late, outfinished for the place. GRAVEL ROAD settled off the pace in the two path, went evenly in lacking a late kick. ZOTIKOS steadied in tight late in the first turn, raced back, moved out, improved a bit in the drive. STRONG BRUSH settled off the pace and the inside, three wide into the lane, lacked a late kick. RUSTOWN HERO devoid of early foot, picked off a couple of tiring foes while not a threat. DAISY BOY moved a bit closer after a half, had nothing left in the drive. CRONUS fractious in the gate prior to the start, tired. CHICKAWAW CHARLIE trailed throughout in showing little.
