STORM HALF saved ground while off the pace but within striking distance, moved out to be three wide second turn, roused, rallied and finished well to prove best outside. ATTEMPTED HUMOR void of speed after being in tight at the start, continued back, saved ground when beginning to move second turn, finished with good late energy to miss. ATTHEBUZZER closest to the leader, took over from that one turning into the stretch, narrowly failed to last. LEESTOWN GIFT forwardly placed off the inside, challenged three wide in the second turn, failed to follow through with that bid in the drive. MYLEKA in some traffic into the first turn, raced off the pace, moved a bit closer in the two path entering the stretch, flattened out. IDE BETTER WIN lacked speed, failed to muster a bid when asked in the drive. CYA LATER BERT bothered start, trailed most of the way, wide into the lane. BOWLING bothered carried out into the first turn, faded while well out in the strip. FLYING IDE got out both turns, faded. SNOOK set the early pace toward the inside, stopped when headed second turn.
