Footnotes

PRISCILLA'S BOY reserved in the early part, racing in the middle of the field, moved up around the final turn and drove clear. RARE LUKEY went to the front, drove clear, couldn't match strides late with the winner, but was best of others. MIDNIGHT CURFEW raced in the back of the pack, made a steady gain, but proved no match for the top two. CAT'S CAUSEWAY pressed the early pace, weakened late and lacked a finish. DEVILISH WAYS raced near the back in the beginning, improved position, but was no factor. CASH MONEY lacked early speed, moved up, but was no factor. UBETA HOPE pressed the early pace and faded. FLAWLESS PRIZE raced in the middle of the field, drifted out around the first turn and was no threat late. DARK TUNNEL was an early factor and dropped back. BAMA BAYOU GATOR void of early speed and was never close.
