**Footnotes**

MONY CHIP four wide in the first turn when well off the pace, made a good gain while continuing outside in the second turn, floated out by the winner turning for home, outfinished that rival in a long drive in game fashion. BUMP IT UP PUCKER got clear early, set the pace while off the inside, continued to show the way through the second turn, floated the winner out turning for home, outfinished by that rival late. SUESTAMER settled off the pace, moved closer in some traffic second turn, dropped inside for the drive, finished up evenly to prove best of the others. DOUBLEDOWNANWIN lacked speed, moved closer with a three wide middle move in the second turn, flattened out in the drive. HIT THAT STRIKE bothered slightly start, moved up through traffic in the early going, prompted the pace outside, had little left for the drive. JOHN ETBAUER steadied early in traffic past the wire the first time, raced back, four wide far turn, improved position without posing a serious threat. CANE CUTTER four wide into the first turn, trailed for a half in lacking speed, passed tiring rivals. FASEAUX forwardly placed early, faded. HIGH MAGIC pressured the pace early, shuffled back in some traffic far turn, continued to fade. MY FRIEND ROY TOO was finished early.
