YES IT'S FRIDAY away in good order, fell back off the pace and the inside, asked from between rivals turn, came three wide into the lane, roused, in time outside. DIXIEPIXICAT vied up front off the inside, dueled out of the turn, held the advantage late, could not contain the winner. FISHIN ATCHEE broke well, prompted the pace three wide, lodged a mild bid three wide turning for home, fell back a bit off the leaders upper stretch, gained the show late. STONE COLD CRAZY moved up inside after the start, set or forced the pace until a sixteenth remained and weakened. RUN N SASSY raced back and inside, closer into the lane but lacked serious late kick. MARDI GRAS LADY four wide through the turn, failed to rally. SASSY DELIGHT brushed at the start, also failed to threaten. PETITE REAPER saved ground to no avail and remained back. TOUGH UPCOMING hit the gate at the start, tired. RUFF N WITTY off slowly, fell further back and was distanced after losing contact with the field.
