I'D BE A SECRET pressed the pace, took the lead around the final turn, drove clear and won under steady urging. CAJUN COUNTRY raced within contention, made a late bid, proved no match for the winner, but was a clear second. POPPA DUKE lacked early speed, moved up on the inside down the backside, made a late bid and proved no match for the top two. JEFF T. sprinted clear, moved to the rail and lacked a late finish. TACO TODDY lacked early speed, raced three wide around the final turn, moved up and finished evenly. LOUISIANALAGNIAPPE pressed the early pace, saved ground and faded. STORMY SURGE void of early speed, raced four wide around the final turn and was never close. GRIM HOOLIGAN raced in the middle of the field, came around the first turn four wide and faded. BATTLE PRINCE raced in the middle of the field and dropped back.
