FOUR BITS was inside and saving ground then rallied and swung out three wide, was in a strong drive and powered to the front in late stretch. LONELY BULL rallied two wide on the turn making a bid in upper stretch but was outfinished in the end. MONTY LIGHTNING chased the pace then rallied and gained command, drew off but weakened in late stretch. BYE BROWNIE stalked the pace while racing three wide then made a bid but weakened in the stretch. RAIL'S GENUINE BOY was inside on the turn then made a mild rally. TORMENTA DEL TIGRE was in tight heading into the turn then made a mild rally in the stretch. MILL STONERUNNER three wide on the turn then was no factor. BEND THE RAIL was unhurried early and no factor. EXCELLENT MOON was four wide, used up and stopped in the stretch. SNOOKIE T showed good early speed, was used up and stopped in the stretch.
