COREY'S RED BOY was stalking the pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn to take command then drew off in upper stretch and held sway in the end. JULIE'S RED BANDIT was settled for the run down the backstretch while racing three wide, rallied making a bid to late stretch but was second best in the end. LAPILE CREEK chased the pace while inside on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn but came up empty in late stretch. GROOM'S DAY was inside on the backstretch then made a bid two wide on the far turn, was blocked in the middle of the far turn, angled inside in upper stretch but failed to challenge in the end. TRAINING ROOM was unhurried early then made a mild rally while wide on the far turn, stayed five wide in the stretch and was no threat. SILENT COUNT was forced to altered course entering the first turn then failed to menace. JUSTINIAN was inside heading into the first turn and forced to steadied sharply off rivals heels then failed to menace. DR. SEVENCOMELEVEN set the pace, drew off on the backstretch, was used up then stopped in the stretch. ELUSIVE COMMANDER was five wide on the backstretch while being outrun. MARGO'S VENTURE was forced to altered course entering the first turn then raced five wide on the backstretch and was outrun.
