ART GOT EVEN stalked the pace while racing three wide, rallied on the far turn then drew clear in mid stretch and was kept to a drive in late stretch. MAJHOOD was allowed to settled then rallied four wide on the far turn, was gaining ground in the stretch was second best. THE WOLF IS BACK was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while three wide, made a bid but was no menace. TWO THREE TWO was allowed to settle while racing on the inside down the backstretch but failed to menace. MIZZEN'S WAKE was bumped at the start by I KAN BOO and the jockey tried to assist his fellow rider from falling from his mount but was unsuccessful, dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive then weakened in drive. BAYBOY dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then weakened on the far turn. BE A DEACON was bumped at the start then was no menace. REDHOTRUSH broke in and bumped hard with MIZZEN'S WAKE causing jockey C. J. McMahon to fall off the side of the horse. A STEWARDS INQUIRY WAS HELD CONCERNING THE START. AFTER REVIEWING THE FILMS, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
