SIR MAXWELL stalked the pace while racing three wide, rallied on the far turn two wide, was inside in the stretch and prevailed after a strong drive. RADIO LOVER was allowed to settled then rallied three wide on the far turn, was in a long drive but came up short in the end. DAT was chasing the pace from the inside, saved ground on the far turn then failed to menace. SAINT BETER dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then faltered in the stretch. BUSTED ACCOUNT was two wide on the backstretch but failed to menace. CARNAC was unhurried early then made a late gain and was no threat. SEVEN POINT SEVEN was unhurried early and no factor. COLTONS SOTO CODE was unhurried early and no threat. ROARING DOWN SOUTH dueled for the lead from the inside, was used up and gave way. SOUTH WEST TARGET was pinched back at the start then was through after a half and stopped.
