JUMP IN LINE was settled in the early going while inside, rallied on the far turn two wide then was in a strong drive to powered up to the front in late stretch. CHERIE'S CASCADE moved up entering the first turn to set the early pace then drew off on the run down the backstretch, was in a long drive but tired in late stretch. SIR STAR was stalking the pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then raced evenly in the stretch. CUZ JOLEE was unhurried early then rallied along the inside on the far turn, made a bid to mid stretch then flattened out. TRIBUTE'S BEST ONE was unhurried early then made a mild rally but was no threat in the stretch. SLIGEAX BEAU was unhurried early and raced three wide on the far turn then was no factor. FLEE THE POSSE chased the early pace while racing four wide on the backstretch, was used up then stopped. EURO CASH stalked the early pace while racing three wide, was used up then stopped. DIXIE DOT RUN stumbled badly at the start going to his nose and unseated the rider. A STEWARDS INQUIRY WAS HELD CONCERNING THE START. AFTER REVIEWING THE FILMS, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
