**Footnotes**

STAR GUITAR was allowed to settle in the early going while racing three wide, rallied three wide into the far turn then moved out to be four wide at the top of the stretch, was in a strong drive and powered to the front in late stretch and was best in the end. MY STAR RUNNER was stalking the pace while racing two wide, rallied on the far turn and was in a strong drive, gained command at the top of the stretch then under left handed urging bore out in late stretch causing crowding then hung in deep stretch. EIGHTH AT CITYPARK was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while five wide, was gaining ground on the outside and finished well in the end. HEAVENVILLE chased the early pace while four wide then rallied three wide on the far turn, was making a strong bid in the stretch then was shut off and forced to steadied off heels of MY STAR RUNNER and lost his action in the end. BREAK UP was inside and saving ground on the backstretch, made a quick move up the inside to gained the lead at the quarter pole then was in a hard drive but tired in the stretch. IDEFROMTHEBAYOU was dueling for the early lead then dropped back and settle, was shuffled back then in tight quarters entering the far turn and taken up then made a mild rally in the stretch. ONE PRETTY PENNY set the early pace on the first turn then was in hand, was collared on the run down the backstretch then gave way on the far turn. OLLIE BABY chased the early pace while three wide, stopped entering the far turn and was eased up in the stretch. A STEWARDS INQUIRY WAS HELD CONCERNING THE STRETCH. ALSO A CLAIM OF FOUL WAS LODGED BY THE RIDER OF HEAVENVILLE AGAINST THE RIDER OF MY STAR RUNNER FOR INTERFERENCE IN LATE STRETCH. AFTER REVIEWING THE FILMS, THE STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED MY STAR RUNNER FROM SECOND AND PLACED HIM FOURTH FOR INTERFERENCE IN LATE STRETCH.
