SOUTH WEST TARGET broke in at the start then pressed the pace while racing two wide, dueled for the lead on the far turn and gamely dug in and proved best in the end. BLADES OF FIRE broke in at the start then set a pressured pace from the inside, dueled for the lead on the far turn then hung in late stretch. BAYOU VERMILION was allowed to settled then was inside on the far turn, was gaining ground but was no menace in late stretch. ANGEL'S CHARIOT was in tight soon after the start and forced to steadied off heels then raced three wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn but came up empty in late stretch. MAGIC WAGON was unhurried early then raced three wide on the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch. SUNDOWNROCKET chased the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up and faltered. OVER IT was unhurried early then was no factor in the stretch. SHAPPA was unhurried early and was no menace. BUD IS CHOICE was outrun. CAPTNRBBY'S APPEAL was outrun. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of ANGEL'S CHARIOT against the riders of SOUTH WEST TARGET and BLADES OF FIRE for interference soon after the start. After reviewing the films, no action was taken.
