MIKE'S SISTER vied for the early lead, came around the turn off the rail, made a late bid and just missed. FUSE IT pressed the early pace, came around the turn on the outside, made a late bid, finished willingly, in a game third. LITTLE ANGEL challenged for the early lead, then tired. KWIK KASH raced in the middle of the field and put forth an even effort. GOODNESS lacked early speed, moved up, but was no factor. CHE NEGRITA (ARG) void of early speed and was never a threat. RED MARIE raced in the middle of the field, then retreated. PERFECT LIL always raced near the back and showed little. MOLLIE MCLASH bobbled at the start, then was pulled up down the backside.
