MR. BARRACUDA was pressing the pace while racing three wide into the turn, was in a long drive and dug in gamely throughout the stretch drive and proved best in the end. HUFFS HUNTER set a pressured pace while two wide, was in a long drive then gamely dug in throughout the stretch but was outfinished in the end. SIR FIVE STAR was three wide into the turn, rallied in upper stretch but was no menace in the stretch. PROLONGED was two wide on the while racing evenly and failed to menace. PART OF MY FAMILY pressed the pace while inside, was hard used then weakened in the stretch. CAMERONLUCKYPRIDE was inside on the turn and no factor. WHO LET THE CAT IN raced four wide on the turn then stopped. GLASS MACHINE was no factor. ORPHAN BRIGADE was outrun. CAT SHOES was three wide then suddenly lost his action at the quarter pole while propping and was pulled up by the rider and walked off.
