A BURN NOTICE raced within striking distance, moved up on the inside, angled out entering the home stretch, made a 3wide bid and drove clear late. KINKY BOOTS broke in, vied for the early lead, took command, but was no match late for the winner. SHIRLEY'S BAY GIRL challenged for the early lead, forwardly placed throughout and lacked a late rally. CRAFTY FEMME ROSE raced near the back in the early part, showed late interest, but was no factor. MOTOROLA JADE pressed the early pace and weakened. BACKSTREET raced in the middle of the field and put forth an even effort. WALKING EAGLE raced near the back and was no factor. BETTER N NUTTIN broke out, slow leaving and was never close. BASICA raced within contention and faded. ATTACAT RACHEL void of early speed and showed little.
