ARCTIC TRIBE vied for the lead while four wide into the turn, was in a long drive then drew off in late stretch. KEYSTONES STRIKE vied for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then weakened but was still second best in the end. THE ARKANSAN was unhurried early then rallied on the turn while four wide, was gaining ground and was no menace. SKYRUNNER vied for the lead while three wide, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch. WESTERN SHOOTOUT was settled then rallied on the turn while two wide, lugged in upper stretch and got his heels clipped then raced evenly in the stretch. GIBSON LAKE vied for the early lead while inside, was shuffled back heading into the turn then was no menace. TIGER BILL chased the early pace while three wide, was used up then faltered. CAMILLE'S CASH was unhurried early and was outrun. ERBYFROMTHEGITGO was far back then avoided a fallen rider in the stretch. ELLIE'S FLYER was two wide in the early going then was blocked heading into the turn, made a bid two wide then was shut off and clipped heels of WESTERN SHOOTOUT losing her rider at the sixteenth pole then was walked off.
