HOTRUNNINWATER was four wide into the turn and was in a strong drive to powered up to the front in mid stretch then drew off late. DOENY'S RIFLE dueled for the lead while inside then drew off on the turn, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch but held the place safe in the end. CHLOE'S HIPPIE was inside then shuffled back on the turn, came again in late stretch while two wide and finished well. KINGSIZE SHOE NAMI dueled for the early lead while two wide, was in a long drive then weakened in the end. WHAT'S UP POP rallied four wide on the turn making a bid then flattened out in late stretch. I'M NO PLUTO chased the early pace while three wide, was hard used and gave way. DIAMOND LAKE HONEY was four wide into the turn and no factor. SKY'S CHAMP raced three wide into the turn and was no threat throughout.
