THE PIPSTER was settled then rallied four wide on the turn, drew off in upper stretch then was kept to task in late stretch. ZIPPY WAGER was settled inside then moved out to be two wide and rallied on the turn, was gaining ground in late stretch to be second best. LA BELLE TE FILLE set the early pace then was in tight quarters on the turn and checked up sharply, dropped back then came again while two wide to finished well. REGAL LEAH chased the early pace wide three wide into the turn, was hard used then faltered in the stretch. MILLENIAL STORM raced two wide on the backstretch then made a three wide bid on the turn but was no threat. WIDE OPEN RAE rallied three wide into the turn then bore in on turn then stopped in late stretch. A CLAIM OF FOUL WAS LODGED BY THE RIDER OF WIDE OPEN RAE AGAINST THE RIDER OF THE PIPSTER FOR INTERFERENCE ON THE TURN, AFTER REVIEWING THE FILM'S, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
