**Footnotes**

AKA LILY'S LAD stalked the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn and dueled for the lead in mid stretch, drew away then held sway in the end. SWEET DIXIELAND was allowed to settle while inside, was inside on the far turn making a run then stayed inside for the stretch drive, was gaining ground in late stretch but was too late while finishing well. GONE LA. set the early pace from the inside, was dueling for the lead from the inside on the far turn, was use dup and weakened in late stretch. WALLACE WAY was inside and saving ground into the far turn, made a bid but came up empty in late stretch. LATCH LIGHTING was allowed to settle while racing two wide on the backstretch, made a bid heading into the far turn then faltered in the stretch. FIRST COMMAND was allowed to settle then failed to menace. MIRACLE CREEK was unhurried early and was no threat. MALABAR CROWN was unhurried early then failed to be a factor. SCHUMACHER was through after a half while inside and stopped back. JUST LUCK was pressing the pace while two wide, was used up then stopped on the far turn.
