HOLD ON LEDELL was bumped at the start then was settled, started a run on the backstretch then circled the field with a strong move four wide on the far turn, moved up to take command in upper stretch then drew off in upper stretch and was clearly best. MR BARRETTE RUN dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch but held the place safe in the end. BAYOU DAWG was unhurried early then rallied on the inside on the far turn, was gaining ground in late stretch but was no menace in the end. MAGICAL DEELITES was bumped at the start then chased the early pace while racing four wide on the backstretch, made a strong bid on the far turn three wide to mid stretch then weakened in the drive. KING REX broke in and bumped with the winner at the start, raced on the inside down the backstretch and saved ground then was evenly in the stretch drive. MISTA BAD ATTITUDE was unhurried early then swung out to be five wide in upper stretch but was no menace in the stretch. TIGER TAYLOR was bumped and pinched back at the start then was unhurried early, raced three wide on the backstretch then was no factor in the stretch. DOO WAP DADDY dueled for the lead while two wide, was used up then gave way in the stretch. HEAT PUMP broke out and bumped hard at the start, chased the early pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up and stopped on the far turn.
