DAVY'S RUNNER stalked the pace while racing inside then moved out to be three wide for the run down the backstretch, rallied three wide on the far turn making a bid to take command, drew off then was in a drive to hold sway in the end. PIRATE ISLAND was inside early on and in tight into the first turn, stalked the pace from the inside then made a bid on the far turn, moved out to be two wide in upper stretch then lugged in mid stretch and was making a run but hung in late stretch. VIKING WARRIOR was inside then saved ground in the early going, rallied on the far turn then angled out to be four wide in the middle of the turn, was gaining ground while outside in the stretch but was no threat to the top two. LAYNE'S PAL raced four wide on the backstretch then rallied on the far turn while three wide, made a bid to upper stretch then flattened out in the drive. ROCKET KING was allowed to settle while racing on the inside down the backstretch then failed to menace. I'MABADBOY was five wide on the first turn then made a steady advance on the backstretch, ranged up to contention on the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. MY BELL BOY raced four wide on the backstretch then failed to menace. KEEP ON SMOKIN was unhurried early and was no threat. TOUGH AS NAILS duelled for the lead while two wide, was used up then was squeezed from between rivals on the turn and steadied sharply and stopped in the stretch drive. SUN SHADOW duelled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive then under strong right handed urging shield from a rival and attempted to jump the inside rail just inside the sixteenth pole, unseated his jockey then was walked off. A STEWARDS INQUIRY WAS HELD CONCERNING THE INCIDENT IN THE STRETCH. AFTER REVIEWING THE FILMS, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
