BG SILVER SNOW raced in the back of the pack, came around the second turn four wide and was a clear second at the wire. DALE HOLLOW raced in the middle of the field, came around the first turn four wide, made a bid and proved third best. SIMPLY JONES pressed the early pace and faded. BULL ISLAND pressed the early pace, saved ground around the final turn and retreated. CUVEES BEST went to the front, drove clear and was finished early. SLEWS TO YOU void of early speed and showed little. KISSIN ALYZIG lacked early speed and was never close.
