LONE PINE was pressing the pace while inside then dropped back heading into the turn, rallied two wide in the middle of the turn, powered to assume command in mid stretch then drew clear in the end. MAUK SALT rallied three wide on the turn, made a strong bid in the stretch but was second best in the end. ARISTOCRAT AGAIN was unhurried early then rallied four wide in upper stretch, closed with a rush in late stretch but was too late. HIGH KICKER chased the early pace while racing three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch then came up empty in late stretch. SIR TRENT was unhurried early then made a mild rally while six wide in the stretch but was no menace. ATRO broke slowly from the gate then was moved up into contention, raced two wide in the turn and in upper stretch, was two wide in mid stretch and squeezed from between rivals and lacked a closing bid. FAST LARRY T set the pace then drew off in the turn, was used up then stopped in mid stretch. BOREGO'S BARBARIAN was angled in then saved ground on the turn, was still inside and blocked behind rivals in mid stretch then steadied off heels. FORTY WON'S IDEE was outrun. SCRIVCO was outrun. A TRAINER CLAIM OF FOUL WAS LODGED BY THE TRAINER OF ATRO AGAINST THE RIDER OF MAUK SALT FOR INTERFERENCE IN MID STRETCH. AFTER REVIEWING THE FILMS, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
