SOILED DOVE dueled for the lead while inside, was in long drive then weakened in the stretch and held the place safe in the end. ANSILTA was allowed to settle then raced on the inside on the far turn making a bid but failed to menace in the stretch. I DAZZLE was unhurried early then made a mild rally while two wide in the stretch but was no threat in the end. TIFFANY'S SONG dueled for the lead while two wide, was hard used then faltered. FOXY NATIVE was no factor. ELLE POINT chased the pace while racing two wide, was used up then faltered. BOYDS PRIZE was outrun. KINGS SALTWORKS trailed throughout.
