NACHO BUSINESS stalked the pace while inside on the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn then slipped through the inside in upper stretch and quickly drew clear in mid stretch and was clearly much the best. HERP was settled in the early going, rallied four wide on the far turn, was gaining ground and angled inside in mid stretch and was along for the place. SMOKETHRUKEYHOLE dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then tired in mid stretch. TEXAS CITIZEN dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then drifted off the rail and weakened in the drive. GOODTIMEHADBYALL was allowed to settle while racing on the inside down the backstretch, moved out to be three wide on the far turn but was no menace in late stretch. COLONIAL'S SCORE broke in at the start and bumped hard then was settled, rallied four wide on the far turn then was no threat. ATLANTIC BULL bobbed at the start then was pinched back from both sides and taken up off heels then was no factor. BIG SCRAPE broke out at the start and bumped hard then was no factor.
