COLD AND WINDSWEPT vied for the early lead, drove clear, moved to the rail and won under steady urging. SINUOSITY broke slow, shut off, racing in the back, came around the final turn three wide, rallied down the stretch, couldn't catch the winner, but was a clear second. ISLAND IN THE SAND broke in, pressed the pace, forwardly placed throughout, but proved no match for the top two. MATT'S CAJUN FIRE lacked early speed, showed late interest, but was no factor. DANCING DUDETE showed early speed and weakened. SEFAS WASP raced near the back in the early part, made a bid, then faded. ZARBALINA vied for the early lead, checked around the first turn, drifted out and was no threat late. PRETTY C C raced in the middle of the field and dropped back.
