STRETCH O'BRIEN chased the pace while racing five wide into the turn, rallied and was in a strong drive and was up in the final strides. TOOLENGTHSOFLITE was bumped at the start then vied for the lead while two wide, drew off coming out of the turn then was all out but could not last in the final stride. PROLONGED vied for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch. CAPE SAN BLAS was unhurried early then swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and closed willingly in the stretch drive. BILLY BO vied for the lead while four wide, made a bid then was bumped in mid stretch and tired in late stretch. ACE AND JIM was bumped at the start then was settled while inside, was making a run then was blocked behind rivals in mid stretch and was no menace. CAMERONLUCKYPRIDE raced three wide on the turn and was no menace. CHURCHONSUNDAY was vying for the lead while three wide, was in tight in mid stretch and taken up then lacked a late bid. SALT AND FAST was outrun. PAID UP stumbled badly at the start and trailed throughout.
