SWEET RUSTON was unhurried early while inside, saved ground heading into the far turn while making a run, moved out two wide in upper stretch, was in a strong drive and proved best in the end. SCAMP AND A HALF was settled in the early going then rallied two wide heading into the far turn, gained command drew off on the far turn but was in a long drive and weakened in late stretch. PRODUCTION'S IDOL set the early pace, drew off heading onto the backstretch, was used up and weakened. MOON LARRY was allowed to settle in the early going, raced two wide on the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch. JILL MARIE was settled in the early going then was no threat in the stretch drive. CLASSIC KEY BRIDGE was unhurried early and no factor. PINK STILETTO stalked the pace while racing two wide then made a bid into the far turn, bore out in upper stretch and was eased up in late stretch.
