CROOK'S STINGER unhurried in the early part, made a steady gain and drove clear before the wire. T. C. CHAMP vied for the early lead, took command, was no match late for the winner, but proved best of others. HERESYASIGN lacked early speed, made a late bid, but proved no match for the top two. BELIEVE IM SPECIAL pressed the pace and weakened. FORESTRY GOLD challenged for the early lead and faded. COZY TIME raced near the back, finished wide and was no threat. SONIC WEST raced in the back of the field and showed nothing. DOBLE QUEBRADO pressed the pace, took a bad step down the backside and was pulled up.
