APPELLATE COURT pressed the pace, forwardly placed throughout, drove clear around the final turn and was kept to the task. HEY HERBIE vied for the early lead, saved ground around the final turn, proved no match for the winner, but held on for second. HOUSEBUILDER reserved in the early going, made a bid and was outfinished for second. QUINT'S MALAGRA raced within striking distance, eased back, then showed late interest. FORGETOLEDAN vied for the early lead, saved ground around the final turn and weakened. JENNY'S SAY lacked early speed, raced five wide around the first turn, moved up, but was no factor. GAMETOWN raced near the middle of the field, came around both turns four wide and weakened. FINEST IRISH had an awkward start, lunged out and was never close. WICKED VICE always raced near the back and showed little.
